

Souder Avenue Bridge and Park Access, Columbus, Ohio

The project is new design of 1,400' of roadway, a four span 406' bridge over the Scioto River, relocation of the City's primary electrical distribution system, lighting, floodwall with a gate closure, bikepath, park access road, and right-of-way plans for property acquisition.

The project provides new access to a privately operated restaurant located at Confluence Park. Phase I and II Environmental Site Assessments were performed. This project is part of the Spring-Sandusky Interchange and West Columbus Local Protection Project (Floodwall). CEC completed plans in 1995, and construction was completed in 1998.



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
